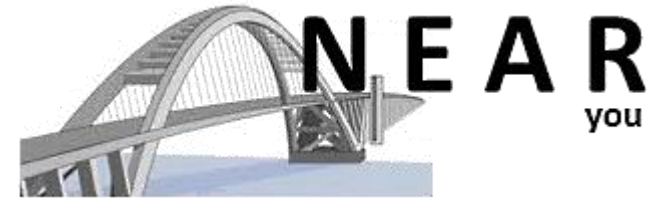


Victoria GARCIA GUILLEN
