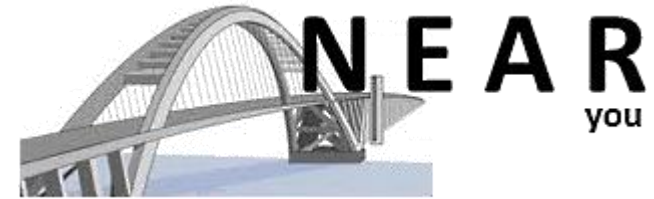


Christoph SORG
